

## Sheep & Lambs:

Farmers who are reaping the benefits from their stubbles and feed barley should also be wary of summer rain. Summer rain is known to encourage and attract blowflies. Preventing fly strike is essential to maintaining a healthy mob, which, when prevented will eliminate potential production and growth losses.

The main prevention treatment product on the market is "Clik" which is a full season blowfly protection with "rain-lock". Clik offers:

- Residual effects for 18-24 weeks
- Rain-lock to prevent wash out
- Use on any wool length up to 3 months before shearing
- Effective in unmulesed sheep
- Only registered product for off shears use

Alternative products in stock include "Cryo-Fly" (back liner) and "Vetrazin liquid" (concentrate) which are both Cryomazine based products. Cryo-fly Blowfly Treatment will protect long wool sheep against fly strike for 11 weeks whilst Vetrazin will treat for 14 weeks, when used as directed.

We can do our best to prevent fly strike but unfortunately we can have the odd occurrence.

In these cases we have a number of treatments available that will make short work of flies, including, "Extinosad aerosol", "Deadmag" and "fly strike powder".
